School Cancellation/Delayed Start Over

Dear Parent(s)/Guardian(s):

In a continuing effort to provide you with the most accurate information, I wanted to take this opportunity to provide you with details related to any possible school cancellations that are the result of the winter weather. As you know, student safety is a top priority of the Lisbon School Department. Based on the information available, the decision to cancel school is generally made between 5:00AM-5:15AM the morning of the inclement weather. As always, if you feel that the conditions are unsafe for your child to attend school, please notify the school directly and we will excuse the absence.

On November 20, 2017, an agreement was reached and a revised schedule was developed that will allow us to have a one or two hour delayed start to the school day. As a result of this change in our school cancellation procedures, it is very important that you listen to the phone message and read the television notifications on mornings when there is inclement weather.

Our primary method of notifying parents is by phone using our SchoolMessenger automated system. It is important that we have an accurate phone number on file so please contact your child's school if your number has recently changed. You can also notify the school if you wish to be removed from the early morning school cancellation/delayed start notification call list.
